**Real Life Situation:** Your real life situation must be a SITUATION and it must be REAL. Not a fact or something from a movie. It can be personal or it can be a current event or something that you read in a textbook. It must lend itself to analysis from a TOK perspective; i.e.: it should present knowledge issues.

**Source:** If it is a personal experience, write "Personal Experience." If it is a current event, cite the article or news story where you read/heard about it. This can be just a URL link. If you found it in a book, write the page number. (If it is anything you read about on the internet, just the URL will do.)

**Possible KQ:** In your presentation, you will be analyzing knowledge questions that were "sparked" by your RLS. You will have one central KQ, but subsidiary KQs might come up. Try to include more than one for each RLS. Remember that a KQ is about knowledge, not about the actual content.

YOU MAY NOT USE RLS/KQs from any TOK website or the textbook. The RLSs and KQs must be your own.
