Directions: Part I

Read and text-mark (underline main ideas) chapters: 11, 13, 14, 19, 21, & 22. Expect a test on these chapters rotation 2.

Directions: Part II Read *Lord of the Flies* once for plot and characters; read a second time for the following:

Highlight in yellow each time the author mentions any of the motifs (symbols, objects, etc. that the author repeats) listed below. Next, label the motif in the margin using one of the words below (in any color but black or red). Third, below each label, annotate for the author’s use and purpose of the motif in **blue ink**. You must annotate **throughout the entire novel**. Expect to have approx. 4 or 5 annotations per page.

Ex: Highlight text in yellow. Annotation in margin: “island” (label and underline)/ Geography as isolation from society (annotation in **blue**)
