## HOW TO GET AN IB DIPLOMA...

### A. ASSESSMENTS: Internal & External

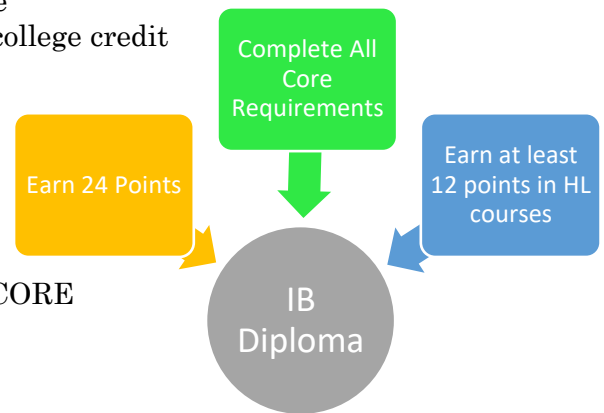
- Internal: Dates/Types vary between classes – See individual teacher for more information
  - i. Teacher Assigns IA – Teacher Scores IA using IB Rubric – IB Selects IAs to be moderated – Student receives IA score
- External (Papers): The end of year Exams, taken in MAY and vary per course – Graded by Moderators around the world
  - i. Students take EA at the end of senior year – Exams are sent to moderators – Students receive scores

### B. SCORES: Students receive a score of 1-7 in each of their 6 IB Courses

- Included: IA + EA = 1-7 Score in each course
- Students earning a 4 or higher will receive college credit

### C. CORE COMPONENTS:

- EE – Extended Essay
- TOK Paper – Theory of Knowledge Paper
- CAS – Creativity, Activity, Service Hours
- Students can earn up to 3 bonus points for CORE



### Important reminders:

- Do not blow off IA's – May count as much as 55% of grade
- Keep in mind; a score a "5" in one HL class, will balance another course with a score of a "3"
- Utilize Managebac for ALL CAS Hours – DO NOT wait to upload all of your hours – Must be complete by May 30, 2021
- **COMMUNICATE** with your teachers, Ms. Sprinkle and/or Ms. Batista with concerns/issues
- Stay on top of deadlines, you do not want things to pile up
