Grant Goals:

The goal of IB LINK's Teach Grant Program is to empower teachers to advance the International Baccalaureate (IB) mission of developing lifelong learners who thrive in a global society and make a meaningful impact. Grants will support innovative educational practices, professional development, and classroom resources that align with IB principles while fostering inquiry-based learning, critical thinking, and global citizenship.

- **Project Focus:**
Projects should enhance student engagement, develop learner profile traits, or further the goals of the IB curriculum.
 - **Use of Funds:**
Funds should be used to improve teaching practices, support professional development, or provide classroom resources related to the IB Program.
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Application Process:

- Submit a completed application form with a detailed project proposal, timeline, and budget.

Grant Amount:

- Grants may range from \$100 to \$3,000, depending on the scope of the project and available budget.

Evaluation:

- Each grant request will be reviewed by the Robinson's IB Coordinator and Principal to assure funds cannot be allocated from other resources.
 - IB LINK Finance committee will vote on awarding grant after receiving input from administration.
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Grant Fundable Items:

The following categories are eligible for funding:

1. Professional Development:

- Registration for IB workshops, conferences, or training programs.
- Courses or certification in IB-related subjects or pedagogical strategies.

2. Classroom Resources & Materials:

- Supplemental textbooks, workbooks, software, and exam preparation materials for the IB Curriculum.

3. Curriculum Development:

- Funding for the creation of new, interdisciplinary units or inquiry-based learning projects.
- Materials and resources to support projects that address global issues or promote sustainable development.

4. Student Enrichment Activities:

- Field trips or virtual experiences to enhance global awareness and deepen learning (e.g., international museum tours, cultural exchanges).
- Guest speakers, workshops, or events focusing on global topics such as sustainability, social justice, or international relations.
- Supplies for student-led initiatives, such as Model United Nations (MUN) activities, student-run conferences, or service-learning projects.
- Funding for substitute teachers to allow IB teachers to accompany students on IB curriculum-related field trips.
